



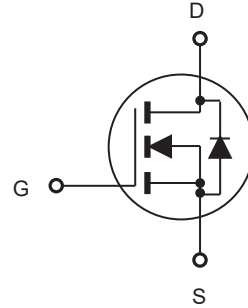
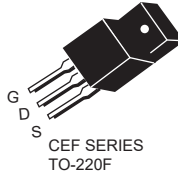

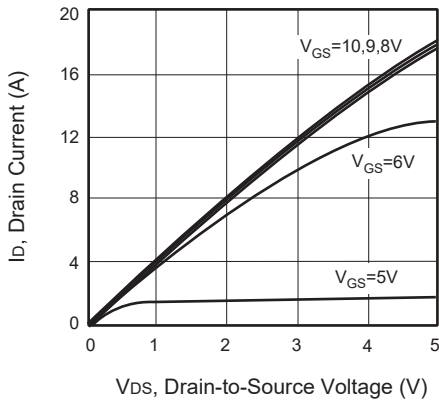


Figure 1. Output Characteristics

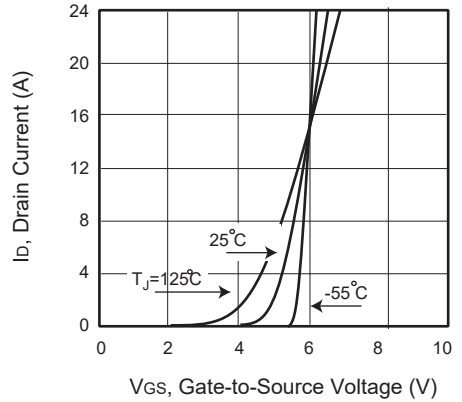


Figure 2. Transfer Characteristics

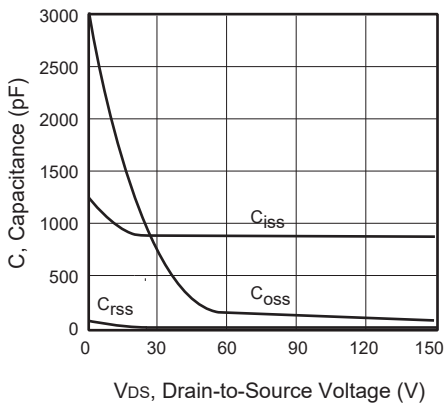


Figure 3. Capacitance

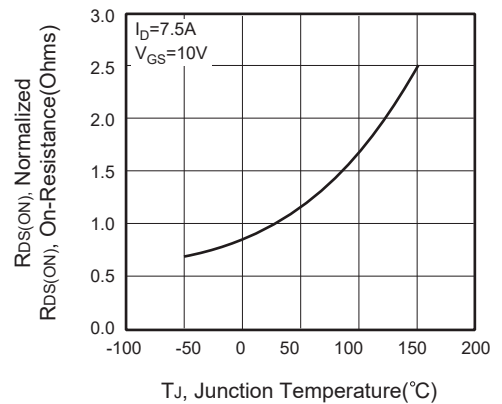


Figure 4. On-Resistance Variation with Temperature

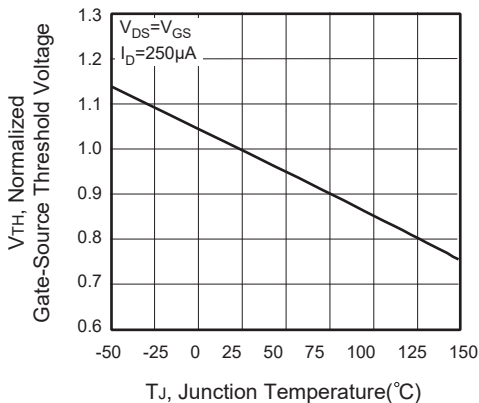


Figure 5. Gate Threshold Variation with Temperature

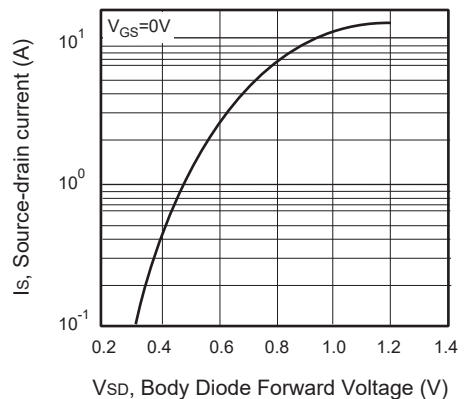


Figure 6. Body Diode Forward Voltage Variation with Source Current

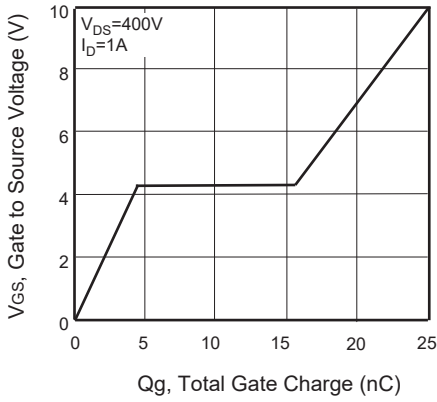


Figure 7. Gate Charge

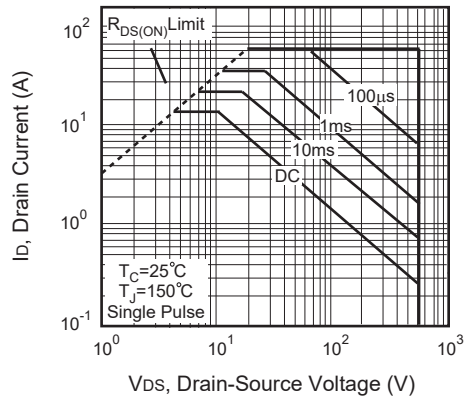


Figure 8. Maximum Safe Operating Area

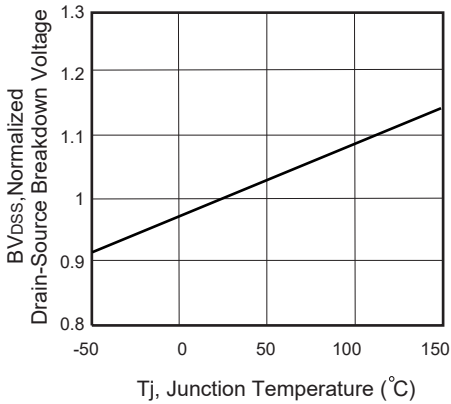


Figure 9. Breakdown Voltage Variation VS Temperature

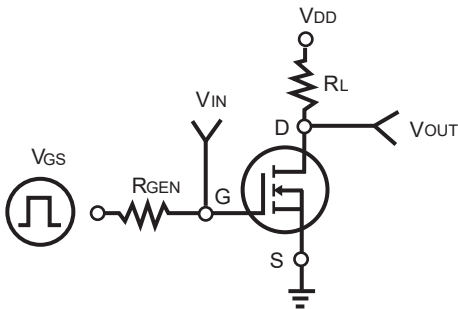


Figure 10. Switching Test Circuit

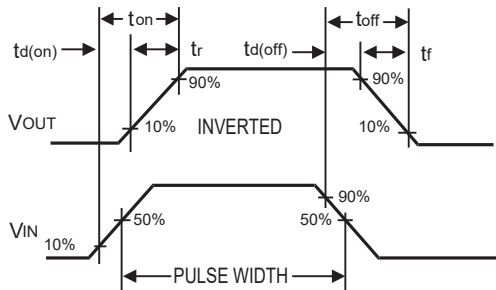


Figure 11. Switching Waveforms

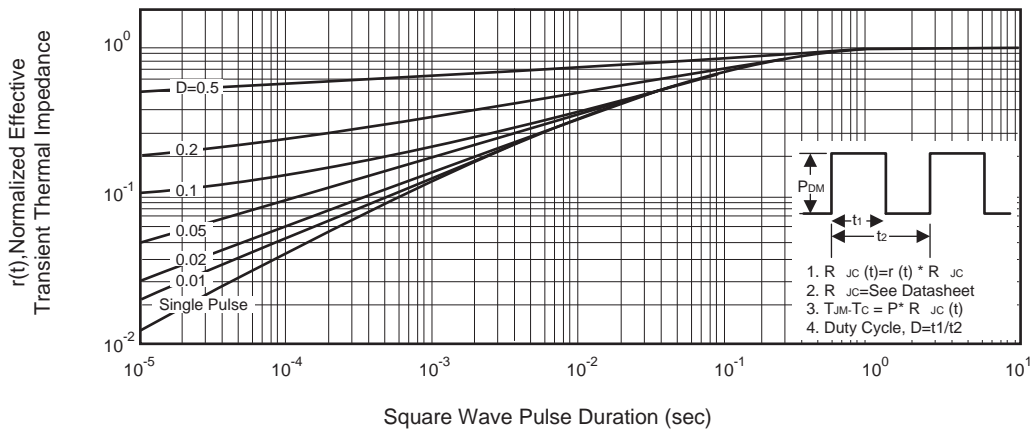


Figure 12. Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance Curve
